Private 4684738 Tom Horberry

He is buried in grave No 32. At the outbreak of hostilities in WW2 he was a private in the KOYLI (Kings Only Yorkshire Light Infantry). Because there was no RAF Regiment at that time he was given duties of guarding the airfield. On returning from a raid on the 28th September 1940, one of our damaged aircraft crashed into his sentry hut and he was sadly killed. His is the only soldier grave amongst the war graves.
