Sgt Barry's Lancaster was one of 42 planes which had been dispatched to lay mines in the Gironde estuary near Bordeaux. All but two planes returned safely. The aircraft in which Sgt Barry was navigator crashed near Binbrook. A New Zealander, he was a member of the Royal Australian Aircraft.
